TASS provides a long-term, integrated system of embedded professional development, coaching and leadership support within a system of collaborative implementation that is tailored to the long-term goals and short-term needs of each school.

- **TASS Certificate of Learning Design Learning, Connecting & Leading in the 21**<sup>st</sup> **Century** - Teacher Leader Certificate - 18 credit sequence in partnership with Castleton College to earn a VT-HEC Certificate for mastery and application of brain-based learning principles, collaboration, leadership and professional learning in standards-based learning, 21<sup>st</sup> Century context. Can lead to Master degree at Castleton.
