Who should attend: Paraeducators

This new training is based on the Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) certification of the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB). It is designed for paraprofessionals and others desiring these competencies working in education, mental health and related fields. This training will provide an excellent foundation of knowledge and skills needed to implement many behavior and education intervention plans.

Training topics are taken from the RBT Task List and fall under the categories of: Measurement, Assessment, Skill Acquisition, Behavior Reduction, Social Skill Instruction, Documentation and Reporting, Ethics and Professional Conduct and Scope of Practice. This offering is designed to give paraprofessionals the background necessary to implement a plan designed by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA), Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA) or appropriately trained behavior specialist or professional educator.

This 40 hour training experience is designed to meet the training requirement for the RBT credential with an option to receive 3 undergraduate college credits. Participants taking the course will meet for a follow-up day in October and be required to complete additional assignments.

This program is offered independent of the BACB by fully certified BCBA's. Additional supervision and successful completion of the RBT exam is required to be officially awarded the RBT credential through the BACB.
