Functional Behavior Analysis to Behavior Intervention Planning

For teachers, special educators, administrators and counselors to gain in-depth knowledge and confidence in using data to inform best practices in providing positive behavior interventions and supports for students with challenging behavior.

Day One focuses on developing a Tier 2 and Tier 3 systems response to identifying and supporting challenging behavior through the use of functional behavior analysis.

Day Two focuses on developing positive behavior interventions and supports at all three tiers of an RTI or PBiS system. Emphasis will also be placed on behavior intervention planning at Tier 3 for students exhibiting significantly challenging behavior.

Benefits of FBA To BIP Training:

- Become familiar with school systems issues as they relate to behavior, discipline and student programming
- Learn how to build a sustainable system of function based behavior support and a behavior support team
- Learn to conduct a functional behavior assessment and use data effectively to inform behavior intervention planning and progress monitoring
- To recognize the factors that contribute to a positive learning environment and that reduce challenging behavior
- Learn research-based steps for de-escalating behavior and responding to students in crisis.
- To identify steps for teaching replacement behaviors

Tiffany Cassano has been a classroom teacher, special educator and school administrator. She is currently teaching graduate courses at Castleton State College as well as the VT-HEC special ed. licensing program. In addition to being a private consultant in Vermont school districts, she works with the Vermont Department of Education Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) as a team member, consultant and presenter and is a CPI trainer.
