Each and Every Child and Family is a series of three connected workshops that provide an in-depth look at including all children and families in quality early learning and development programs. This workshop series is designed for early childhood educators and early childhood special educators working with infants, toddlers, and preschoolers in a variety of settings (Head Start, early care and education centers, home-based child care programs, and prekindergarten programs).

Workshop #1: Framing the Discussion

All children thrive in a nurturing, engaging environment with peers; however, children with behavioral challenges, developmental delays, who are dual language learners, or who learn differently do not always have access to inclusive early childhood settings. This workshop is designed to provide information on evidence based practices and resources that will help transform early childhood settings into places that can meet each and every child and family's needs.

Workshop #2: Functional Goals and Planning

All young children need to develop the skills required for them to function and succeed at home and/or in an early care and education setting. For some children, developing these functional skills requires adults' thoughtful planning of intentional teaching and individualized learning opportunities. This workshop delves into identifying the child's functional goals and planning ways to support the child meeting those goals.

Workshop #3: Implementing Learning Opportunities that Support Inclusion

This workshop will build upon the DEC/NAEYC joint position statement on inclusion's three main features of access, participation, and professional development that were presented in Workshop 1. Participants will be introduced to and practice using *Cara's Kit* (*Creating Adaptation's for Routines and Activities*).
