This three part workshop series or four part 3 credit graduate course (choose to participate either way) will examine how educators can utilize technology to increase students' independent learning and their access to the curriculum. We will examine and explore:

- a process for educators and teams to help determine which technology to trial and how to collect meaningful data on its impact
- powerful technology tools to help students read, write and take notes
- specific case studies with time for focus group work around individual learning challenges
- resources to help find additional technology to support students

Between the three sessions participants will be able to trial technology with their students and receive direct feedback from the instructor. This workshop is designed for educators, special educators and paraeducators interested in learning how to use technology to enhance their students' learning.
